Notes from panel discussion on Keeping a Pure Mind, with Dr. Phil Brown, Dr. Allan Brown, and Rev. Cravens.

- Proverbs 4:23, Guard your heart with all diligence for your life flows out of your heart.
- Matthew 12:34, out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. You are fooling yourself if you believe you can think wrong thoughts but not actually do wrong.
- Philippians 4:8, Whatsoever things are pure...
- 2 Corinthians 10:4-5, we are in a warfare, the devil is out to destroy us (John 10:10).
- 1 Corinthians 10:31, do whatever you do to God's glory
- Proverbs 28:13, he that covers his sin will not prosper.
- A deliberate choice to think and dwell on impure thoughts is willful sin.
- Jesus said in Matthew 5:28 if you even lust you have committed adultery.
- Marriage is not the cure for impure thoughts.
- It's not a function of the sexual glands or organs it's a functioning of the mind.
- A pure mind is a function of loving God and others.
- A pure mind flees (2 Timothy 2:22) from attractive opportunities to lust.
- A pure mind is not the absence of temptation
- A pure mind meditates on God's word (Psalms 1:3)
- Romans 13:14, Put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for the flesh to fulfill it's lusts.
 - Make provision = allow opportunities
 - Flesh = that part of you that can be tempted
 - Lust = desire
